1) What is the full <b>legal</b> name of parolee/convicted felon?
2) Does the parolee/convicted felon have any aliases? What are they?
3) What is the current address of parolee/convicted felon?
4) What crime was the parolee/convicted felon convicted of?
5) What year was the parolee/convicted felon convicted?
6) How long was the term of the parolee/convicted felon's incarceration?
7) How much of that term did the parolee/convicted felon serve?
8) When did the parolee/convicted felon begin his/her parole?
9) How long will the parolee/convicted felon be on parole?
10) What is the Parole Officer's full name?
11) What is the Parole Officer's complete mailing address, email address and telephone numbers (if applicable)?
12) Please submit a coloured copy of parolee's/convicted felon's passport data page.
